
Traditional Prayer for the Anglican Rosary



The Cross:

O God, make speed to save us. O Lord, make haste to help us.

The Invitatory Bead:

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, as it was in the beginning, is now, and will be forever. Amen.

The Cruciform Beads:

(The Lord's Prayer)

Our Father who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come, thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. For thine is the Kingdom, and the power and the glory, forever and even. Amen.

The Week Beads:

(The Jesus Prayer)

Lord Jesus Christ, Son of the Living God, have mercy on me, a sinner.

The Last Cruciform Bead:

The Lord bless you and keep you. The Lord make His face to shine upon you and be gracious to you. The Lord lift up His countenance upon you and give you Peace. Amen.

The Dismissal Bead:

(Invitatory Bead) Let us bless the Lord. Thanks be to God.

The Cross:

The almighty and merciful Lord, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, bless us and keep us. Amen.
